Special Notice: A Sensible Use for Your Old Cell Phones!

At our April and May 2008 meetings we are collecting old cell phones and batteries (no chargers or accessories, please) to benefit **Secure the Call Foundation**, a coalition of law enforcement agencies and not-for-profit organizations, which collects, cleans, and redistributes used cell phones to domestic violence centers, senior centers, watch groups, school crossing guards, etc: that is, any community member who needs a 911 phone in the event of an emergency. Any phone that can be turned on can be used to call 911, even without a carrier service plan, so your old phones can be put to good use.
