He is also the clinical outreach coordinator for The Family Foundation School, a therapeutic boarding school in NY specializing in the treatment of adolescent addiction. John's past work experience includes EAP consulting at Corporate Counseling Associates and clinical outreach for The Aspen Education Group.

Sandra Gomez, MD, is certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology in General Psychiatry and in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry. She has participated in many prominent research projects, including the Treatment of Adolescent Suicide Attempters (TASA) study. Dr. Gomez has co-authored articles in Anxiety Disorders and ADHD in adolescents, among others. She is an Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at New York University School of Medicine and a second year candidate at NYU's Psychoanalytic Institute.
