Program: “The Dynamics of Spouse Abuse From the Batterer’s Perspective”

Purpose and Content:

To acquaint participants with the emotional and psychological interactions between violent intimate partners from the perspective of the perpetrator of the violence. The lecturer will present material gleaned from 23 years experience developing and leading recovery groups for abusive men. Areas covered will be treatment issues, false justifications for the abuse and commonalities of men who abuse women. Lecturer will explain how these beliefs lead to violent, destructive choices when batterers go to handle conflict in intimate relationships.

Educational Objectives:

Participants will better understand the faulty beliefs and immature attitudes held by most batterers. Also, Participants will be able to plan more effective intervention when working with abusers.
