Program: **“Relationships in Recovery”**

Description:

Representatives from P.O.W.E.R. (Pennsylvania Organization for Women in Early Recovery) will discuss the topic of relationships in recovery as it relates to gender-specialized alcohol and other drug treatment for recovery. Research suggests that because women are socialized differently than men, an approach to treatment that specifically addresses their needs is most effective. Programs that work successfully with substance abusing women recognize that women are more likely to define themselves through relationships with others. For that reason, successful treatment focuses on developing healthy connections with others.

Objectives:

By the end of the presentation, participants will be able to:

1. Identify the guiding principle of growth for women
2. Identify two types of relationships
3. Identify at least three ways relationships with men contribute to women's addiction
4. Identify three practical applications that can be used in the intervention and/or treatment of women
